MARINE PARK FEES

To ensure the conservation and preservation of the Lalang-garram / Horizontal Falls Marine Park, and to provide opportunities for Dambimangari Traditional Owner employment, fees apply to all visitors. Horizontal Falls Seaplane Adventures collects fees on behalf of the Marine Park's joint management body comprising of the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation & Attractions and the Dambimangari Aboriginal Corporation. Fees are payable at the time of booking and are as follows:

\$5.50 per person for day (or part thereof) visitors

\$17.00 per adult and \$7.20 per Child (4-12 years inclusive) for overnight stays

\$10.50 per guest older than 5 years for helicopter or fixed wing scenic flights from the Park

MAKING A BOOKING

SEASON STARTS

Horizontal Falls Seaplane Adventures operate on seasonal basis. The 2021 season commences on 26 March with half day tours and full day tours then commence on 8 April ex Broome. Tours Departing from Derby will commence on 8 May. Thousand Island tours commence on 7 June. Horizontal Falls season comes to a close on 10 November 2021.

WHAT ARE NEAP TIDES?

The Horizontal Falls are a natural phenomenon influenced by fluctuating tides that vary on a daily basis. As this is the case, operations only take place when the predicted tidal movements are not neap, so as to avoid taking guests out when there is the least difference between high and low tide.

The gravitational pull of the moon and the sun affect the Earth's tides on a monthly basis. Neap tides occur in relation to lunar and solar cycles. During either of the two quarter Moon phases, when the Sun and Moon are at right angles to each other and their tidal influences partially cancel each other out, neap tides occur, and the tidal range is minimal. During each lunar month, two sets of neap tides occur.

DATES NOT IN OPERATION DUE TO NEAP TIDES

To ensure that guests have the best possible experience witnessing the incredible tidal power of the Horizontal Falls, Horizontal Falls Seaplane Adventures will not be operating on the highlighted neap tide dates below.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HORIZONTAL FALLS SEAPLANE ADVENTURES TOURS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. BOOKING

CONFIRMED BOOKING

Your booking is confirmed when:

- (1) You have made the booking and have provided Horizontal Falls Seaplane Adventures (HFSA) with all the necessary information to complete the booking;
- (2) We have sent you a booking confirmation

2. BEFORE YOU CAN TRAVEL

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

All guests must declare their weight at time of booking. We cannot carry guests over 120kg. Guests will be weighed at the airport and if you are over your declared weight you may be refused boarding and no refund will be issued.

CHILDREN

We do not accept bookings for children under 4 years of age.

PREGNANCY

The boat ride through the Horizontal Falls may not be suitable for women who are more than 26 weeks pregnant. Any women joining our tour whilst in any stage of pregnancy should seek their doctor's approval prior to travel.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Whilst every care is taken for the safety and wellbeing of our guests, we strongly recommend that all guests arrange their own travel insurance to cover guest cancellation.

3. SEASONS, WEATHER AND TIDES

GUARANTEE OF PASSAGE

The Horizontal Falls are a natural phenomenon which are influenced by fluctuating tides that vary daily. For safety reasons we cannot guarantee passage through the narrow gap on all days.

NEAP TIDES

The Horizontal Falls are a natural phenomenon influenced by fluctuating tides that vary daily. As this is the case, operations only take place when the predicted tidal movements are not neap, to avoid taking guests out when there is the least difference between high and low tide. Neap tides block out dates can be found on our website or rate sheet.

SEASONALITY

HFSA operates seasonally from March to November 2021 and exact season commencement and conclusion dates are subject to change.

4. GUEST AMENDMENTS, PAYMENTS AND CANCELLATIONS

If a guest chooses to cancel within 30 days prior to departures 100% cancellation fees apply.

GUEST AMENDMENTS

Subject to availability, you may amend the date of travel for your booking up to 72 hours prior to the tour departure date free of charge.

CANCELLATIONS

A HFSA tour could be cancelled under one of the following three circumstances:

- (1) a cancellation arising from a guest's actions, through no fault of HFSA – see 'Guest Cancellations' in section 4
- (2) a cancellation by HFSA arising from external consequences that make our performance of the agreement impossible (for example a Force Majeure event, or the actions of a third party e.g. New Government regulations) – see 'Force Majeure Cancellations'
- (3) any other cancellation by HFSA – see 'HFSA Cancellations'

FORCE MAJEURE CANCELLATIONS

For all tours, in the event of a Force Majeure Cancellations, HFSA will provide you with a credit note of an amount equal to the monies paid to HFSA. The credit note can then be applied to the cost of a future tour with us. Time limits and other criteria and conditions may apply.

HFSA CANCELLATIONS

For all tours, in the event of a HFSA Cancellation, HFSA will provide you with the option to receive one of the following:

- (1) amend tour booking to a future date
- (2) choose an alternative tour of equal or similar value
- (3) a full refund of monies paid to HFSA under the booking; or
- (4) a credit note of an amount equal to the monies paid to HFSA

REFUND PAYMENTS

Any credit note or refund payable by HFSA under this agreement will be calculated to take into account the monies actually paid under the booking and the amount of the tour that has been used.

Any refund will be payable to the person who paid for the booking, or to the first person named on the booking. If a booking was made through a Travel Agent, any refund will be returned to that Travel Agent for their payment to the guest.

5. MISCELLANEOUS

SURCHARGES AND CREDIT CARDS

Only Visa and Mastercard are accepted for credit card payments.

A 1% surcharge applies.

WAIVER AND AMENDMENT

A provision of this agreement may not be amended or waived except in writing signed by an authorised representative of HFSA.

6. DEFINITIONS

Force Majeure event means an event or circumstance which is beyond our control and without our fault or negligence and which was not reasonably preventable, including:

- (a) riot, war, invasion or acts of terrorism;
- (b) requisition or compulsory acquisition by any governmental or competent authority, a material change in legislation or directions by a government authority;
- (c) medical outbreak, or contamination of any kind;
- (d) earthquakes, flood, fire or other physical natural disasters; and
- (e) strikes or industrial disputes which affect an essential part of the service
